Blueline Power Developing Nations Kit to enhance lives abroad.

Blueline Power to Install Solar Electric System at Life to the Children Orphanage in Port-au-Prince, Haiti.

Marina, CA, February 19, 2009: Blueline Power CEO, Ed Bless, traveled with a specially packaged solar electric system to the country of Haiti on February 18, 2009 to deliver and install a solar electric system for the Life to the Children Orphanage, just South of Port-au-Prince. The system has been designed to be carried on a common commercial aircraft and can be installed anywhere in the world in one day. Blueline Power chose the Haiti Orphanage since the geographic area represents the highest level of poverty of any country in the Northern Hemisphere. The death rate among children 5 and under is almost 10%. Blueline Power established the "Developing Nations Kit" specifically to meet baseline needs as outlined in the United Nations Millennium Development Goals for ending poverty by 2015. Bless stated that a critical major step to reaching the goals is the establishment of electrification in remote areas, where the lack of electricity debilitates a people group from moving forward. There are more than two billion people today who do not have access to electricity. For less than \$1,000, the Developing Nations Kit can be deployed and replicated by men and women, in concert with micro loans, resulting in employment and cash flow. The installed stand-alone solar electric system provides electricity 24/7 and catalyzes agriculture, medical capabilities, indigenous businesses, LED lighting, and portable computer charging for education and programs which promote awareness for health (including AIDS and prenatal care, as well as general issues) and sustainability.

Blueline Power believes that this simple approach, combined with a concern for developing people, can result in global partnerships that accelerate a reduction in child mortality, hunger, and pollution.
